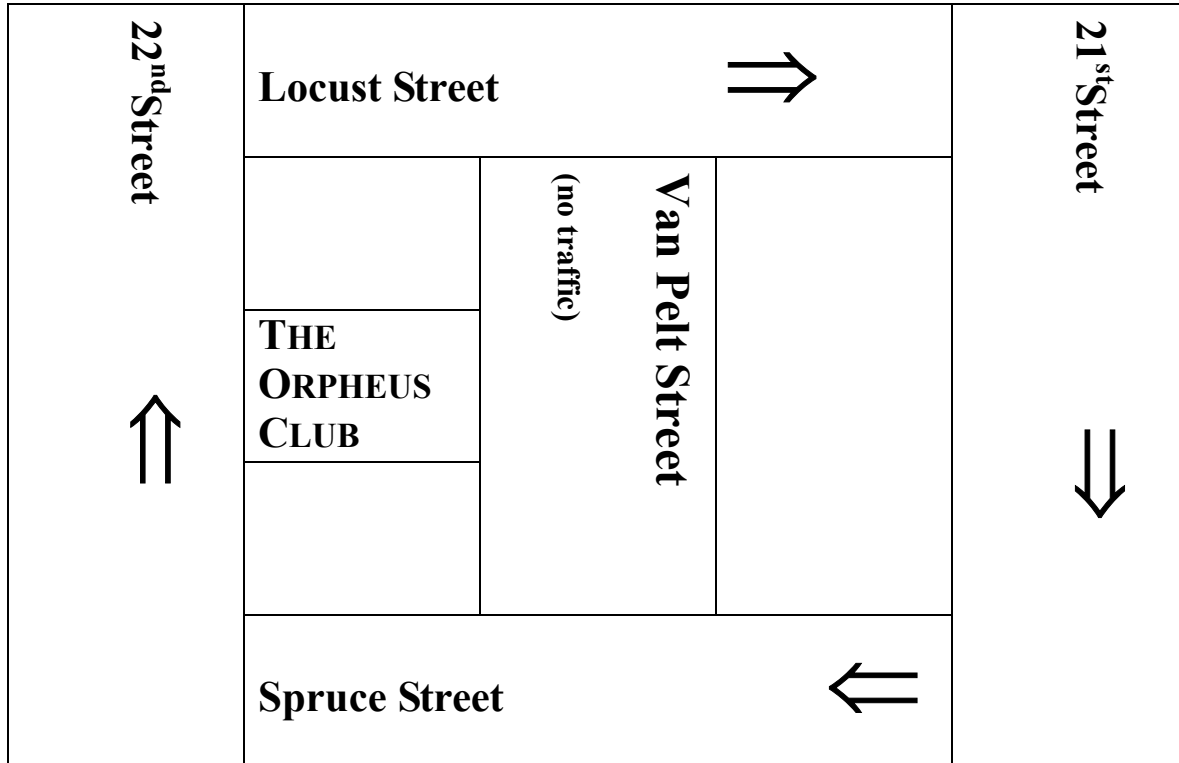

The Orpheus Club of Philadelphia - 254 Van Pelt Street



In Center City Philadelphia, numbered streets run North-South, and tree-named streets run East-West. The arrows show the one-way direction of each street.

If you're looking for parking, there's a lot (not attended) at the corner of 22nd and Walnut Streets. More secure is the Rittenhouse garage on 20th Street, just south of Walnut Street.

In the house, there are four small bathrooms (one toilet each): one on the street level by the front door, one on the upper-level hallway (labeled men's, but can be used by either), and two adjoining the ladies' dressing-and-sitting room.

Our neighbors on Van Pelt Street are quiet-living, and several have very young children. Just try to remember this as you enter and exit the house.
